Product Name: 217 Candle Fragrance Oil.

Olfactory classification: 217 Fragrance Oil belongs to the fruity gourmand, floral woody and powdery musk fragrance groups, with a pronounced citrus-fruity, floral and warm gourmand character. The composition combines notes of blood orange, honey, orange blossom, white jasmine, dry woods, praline, patchouli, powdery musk and a gourmand accord, creating a rich and sophisticated fragrance with a warm, sensual finish.

Fragrance oil description: The composition is rich, elegant and distinctly gourmand, with a luminous citrus opening, an opulent floral heart and a deep earthy-musky base. The fragrance has medium to high intensity, very good diffusion and a long-lasting, sophisticated trail. The opening is built around blood orange, honey and the fruity nuances of orange blossom. Blood orange provides juicy citrus freshness with subtle bitterness and tangy vibrancy, while honey contributes rich, smooth and enveloping sweetness. Orange blossom introduces luminous citrus-floral fullness and further rounds out the opening fruity tones. White jasmine, dry woods and praline unfold in the heart. White jasmine provides intense floral fullness and elegant sensuality, while dry woods introduce a firm woody structure and subtle earthy depth. Praline contributes creamy nutty sweetness and a pronounced gourmand character, giving the heart additional warmth and fullness. The base is built around patchouli, powdery musk and a gourmand accord. Patchouli provides dark earthy depth and persistence, while powdery musk leaves a soft, velvety and sensual trail. The gourmand accord further accentuates the creamy sweetness and extends the composition's warm finish. The dominant accords include blood orange, honeyed floral, white jasmine, praline gourmand and powdery patchouli musk. The fragrance leaves a rich, warm and elegantly gourmand impression.

Applications: 217 Fragrance Oil is intended for the manufacture of scented candles, wax melts, diffusers, air fresheners and other fragranced formulations. It is particularly suitable for luxurious fruity-gourmand, floral, patchouli and powdery-musky collections. The recommended concentration depends on the type of base and the desired fragrance intensity, subject to prior compatibility, stability and diffusion testing. The relevant IFRA Certificate should be consulted to determine the maximum permitted concentrations.
